**To:** Knitweaving participants

**Bring to Class:**

1. Worsted weight yarn of at least 2 different colors, size 9 ndls.
2. Sport weight yarn, size 6 needles.
3. Bulky Weight yarn of yet another color and/or some textured/novelty yarn of any weight.
4. Graph paper, pencils (preferably in several colors), eraser.
5. Tapestry needle.
6. Homework swatches and needles.

**Homework:**

1. With any sport weight yarn and size 6 needles, cast on 17 stitches and work in k 1, p 1 rib for 1". Leave stitches on needle or stitch holder to be picked up and worked later.
2. With worsted weight yarn and size 9 needles, cast on 18 stitches and work in stockinette stitch for 1", end ready to work a knit row. Leave stitches on needle or stitch holder to be picked up and worked later.
3. With worsted weight yarn and size 8 needles, seed stitch for 4" and bind off.
4. With worsted weight yarn and size 8 needles, cast on 19 sts and work in stockinette stitch for 4", end ready to knit, do not bind off but leave stitches on needle or stitch holder.
